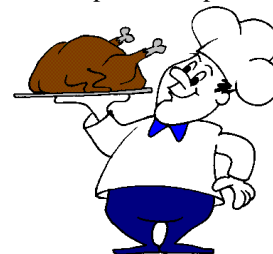
CHARITY GOLF TOURNAMENT
