CHARITY GOLF TOURNAMENT



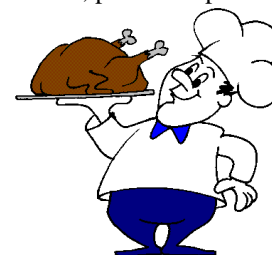
