### DID YOU KNOW???????

On May 8, 1921, a group of Catholic men representing the area of O'Fallon, St. Paul and Josephville applied to the Supreme Council to establish a council in O'Fallon. They received a Certificate of Incorporation from the Supreme Council that enabled them to establish a Charter in the Knights of Columbus, which instituted O'Fallon Council 2269 on May 21, 1921.

Orf, Henry N. Prinster, Henry E. Roeper, Joseph A. Roeper, Joseph F. Saali, Sebastian J Salfen, Leo J Schneider, Anthony Seebacher, Joseph F Sigmund, Sr, Leonard R Sommer, Alex Westhoff, Anton H Westhoff, John A Westhoff, William F Westhoff, Joseph F Zerr and William A Zerr.

Edwin F. Debrecht served as the first Grand Knight of Council 2269 for a period of three years.
